# We're here to help

Care & Repair Edinburgh is a charity providing a wide range of practical services and advice designed to make it easier for older or disabled residents to live independently in their own homes. Our services include handyperson, key safe fitting, joinery repairs, trade referrals, volunteer service, fire alarms, electrical repairs, handrails and grabrails.

#### **Volunteer service**

Our friendly and vetted volunteers can carry out basic household DIY and provide technical help. This is a free service but donations are welcome towards our work.

Some examples of the work our volunteers carry out include:

- Changing lightbulbs/hanging curtains/turning matresses
- Hanging pictures and assembling small flat pack furniture
- TV and digital set ups such as printers, phones and simple computer fixes

### **Key safes**

Installing key safes is one of our most popular services. We supply and fit police approved models making it easier for family and carers to gain access. There is a charge for the key safe and a small fitting fee.

# **Handyperson service**

Our handyperson service can carry out small jobs within your home. There is a minimal labour charge plus cost of any materials for this service.

Some examples of work include:

- Internal/External grabrails
- Large flat pack assembly
- silicone
- curtain rails

## **Joinery service**

Our qualified joiner can carry out minor work in your home. There is a free assessment and a minimal labour charge plus the cost of any materials for this service.

Some examples of work include:

- Replacing broken sash cords and window sills
- Window and door repairs/replace handles
- Fitting handrails, bath or shower aids, draught excluders, locks and security items

We can also assist with small electrical repairs, interlinked fire alarms as well as external ramps and handrail installations.
